LWAH SCHOOL OF EXCELLENCE

LWAH School of Excellence (LSE), is a fully licensed special education school, established under decree number 9402 on November 30, 2012. It had initially started as a special education initiative in 2004, with a group of 15 students, but had since grown to become a reliable academic institution.

LSE receives students with hearing disabilities, mild mental disabilities, physical disabilities, Down syndrome and autism. Students follow the Lebanese academic program in addition to an individualized rehabilitation program that aims at optimizing their abilities and achieving full reintegration.

Believing in early intervention, LSE welcomes students upon their diagnosis with a disability and as early as their first year of age. Such policy has proved successful, and showed tremendous progress on different levels. Older students with no academic background, aged 14+, follow a capacity building program comprising literacy courses, computer skills, life skills, physical education, music and art, in addition to training in LSE's vocational workshops.

Students are accepted at LSE following thorough screening from the admissions committee that reads through multiple medical and psychological tests, to determine their level and designate their class and respective academic program.

LSE's fully accessible classrooms are setup to match international standards, as they are equipped with interactive smart boards, thus maximizing benefit at both student and teacher levels with regards to different individualized educational goals.

LSE is an opportunity for marginalized students who are unfortunately left out of the educational system because of its incapability to attend to their special needs. At LSE they take the challenge and they surely excel!

Our highly competent special educators offer children with disabilities specific designed instructional programs and learning skills. They adapt and develop materials to match the special needs of each student, and use a variety of teaching strategies to ensure that students with disabilities reach their learning potential.
